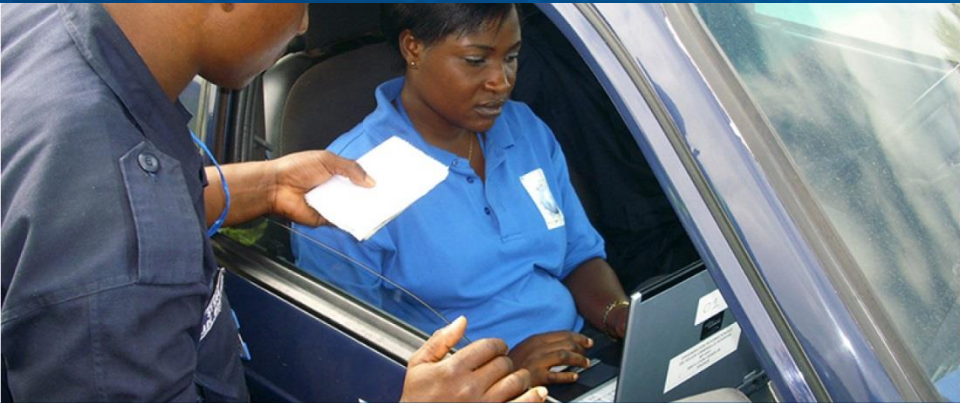

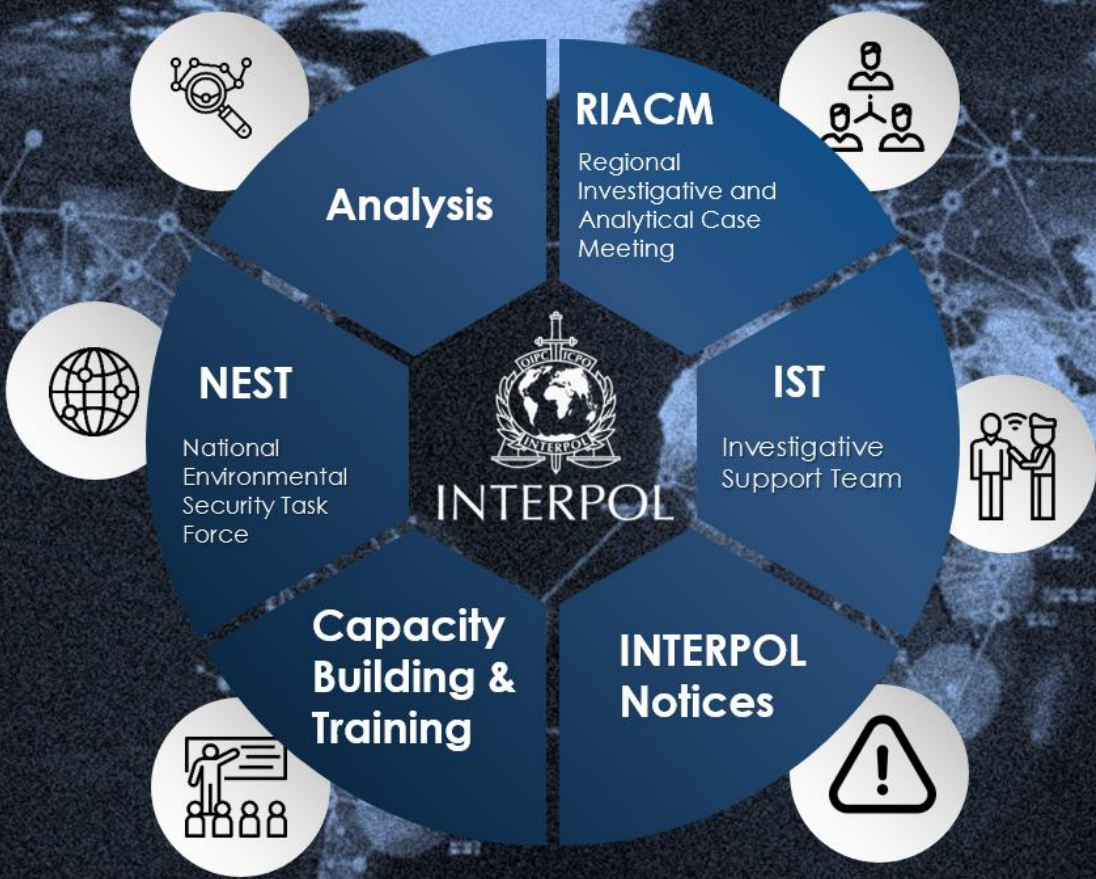

## Capacity Building & Training

INTERPOL Environmental Security provides **criminal intelligence analysis** to support law enforcement activities at both operational and strategic levels.

A **National Environmental Security Task Force** brings together national experts from different agencies to forge multi-agency cooperation and a coordinated approach to combating environmental crime.

INTERPOL Environmental Security regularly provides **training and capacity building activities** to Member Countries.

INTERPOL notices are published through official INTERPOL communication channels to **share critical crime-related information** between member countries.

An **Investigative Support Team** can be requested by a member country to support local law enforcement authorities in their investigations.

A **Regional Investigative and Analytical Case Meeting** allow investigators from member countries to meet face-to-face to review case files and share intelligence and analysis to further support their investigations.
